Marmion Primary School P&C is an association setup to encourage active parent participation in the school community and to provide extra resources to the school for the benefit of all students.

The P&C meetings provide a great opportunity to meet new families, learn about what is going on at Marmion and have a say in how P&C funds are raised and spent.

The P&C works closely with the school community, Principal and teaching staff to identify areas of need within the School. As a result of our fundraising activities, resources can then be allocated as required by the school.

The P&C undertakes a range of fundraising activities throughout the year such as Evening on the Oval, Mothers & Fathers Day stalls, the school disco and the Colour Fun run. The funds we raise must directly benefit all children in the school.

The P&C also run the school uniform shop, assist in the management of the canteen lunch orders, the Scholastic book club, oversees the Friends of the Marmion bushland and the Your Move committees and manages the annual technology levy.

All money raised by the P&C is spent to directly benefit our kids at Marmion. Over the past few years the P&C has been able to contribute nearly \$150,000 back to the school in the form of playgrounds, sporting equipment, iPads, technology leases, Literacy Pro, bike racks, book week authors, canteen equipment and uniforms, library shelving, bushland plants, recycling centres, woodworking and science benches.

Parent participation and involvement is crucial for the successful operation of the P&C. There are many ways to support the P&C from holding an Office Bearer role, being on the executive committee, volunteering for the Your move initiatives, the garden club, supporting fundraising and events, in the canteen and uniform shop. We encourage all families to get involved in whatever capacity you can.

Uniform Shop

Our uniform shop, located on the verandah next to LA14 is open every **Monday from 8:15am** during the school term to purchase items from our school dress code.

Items can be purchased online via Qkr! with the option of delivery to your child's classroom or collection during opening hours.

It is so convenient to be able to access an onsite shop for our uniforms when necessary and it operates thanks to parents who volunteer their time and energy to coordinate the shop.

Technology Fund

We are very fortunate to have a well supported technology fund at Marmion which means that parents do not need to supply and maintain devices for their children.

Voluntary contributions are paid annually per year and directly contribute to the technology available at the school for all students in all learning areas. We encourage families to contribute to this fund via the Campion Education booklist. This fee is currently \$80 per student or \$100 per family.

Your support of this program in 2025 is appreciated and it means the P&C is able to contribute nearly \$15,000 towards new technology and technology leases which will directly benefit our kids learning in all classrooms.
