Character strengths

Fairness is one of the most important values children can learn, as it lays the foundation for positive relationships, responsible decision-making, and a strong sense of justice. When children understand what it means to be fair, they are better equipped to treat others with respect, share resources, and resolve conflicts peacefully. From an early age, children encounter situations where fairness comes into play, whether it's taking turns on the playground, sharing classroom equipment, or playing a game at home. Without guidance, these moments can lead to frustration, selfishness, or conflict. However, when adults model fairness and encourage children to consider the perspectives of others, kids begin to recognise that fairness is not simply about getting what they want, but about ensuring that everyone has a fair chance. Teaching fairness also helps children develop empathy.

By learning to put themselves in others' shoes, they start to see why equality and justice matter. These skills not only strengthen friendships in childhood but also prepare young people to become compassionate, responsible adults who contribute positively to society. In a world where cooperation and understanding are essential, fairness is more than a playground rule, it is a lifelong principle. By fostering fairness early, we empower children to build inclusive communities where everyone feels valued.

Parent Information Booklet: Attendance SMS

Transitioning to the new System

Marmion Primary School is transitioning to a new system, this means all Attendance SMS messages will now come from a new contact MarmionPS.


The new system will notify parents, guardians, and caregivers of unexplained absences or late arrivals.

What will change for Parents?

The new system starts on 19/08/2025. It will send parents an SMS on their mobile phone when their child is marked absent without an explanation.

Parents should delete the old Absentee SMS number to avoid confusion. They should not use it to communicate with the school.

This is a sample message below. Parents will get this SMS with the link if their child is marked absent without an explanation. Parents should use this link to add attendance notes about their child's absence. Please note that the link will be valid for only 48 hours. Do not reply to this message via SMS as the school will not receive it. The school will receive your response via the link provided. Ensure the phone is connected to an Internet data plan or has WIFI access to use the hyperlink.



If the child is absent again without a prior explanation, parents will get a new one-time link.

If parents do not use the link provided, they can notify the school of their child's absence via telephone or email.


